WALKING IN KINGDOM AUTHORITY

1 Co 4:20 (NLT) -- ²⁰ For the Kingdom of God is not just a lot of talk; **it is living by God's power.**

- To walk in kingdom authority we need to take a:
 - DETERMINED WALK, which is being:
 - Determined to see
 - Determined to do
 - Determined to be.
 - DOMINION WALK
 - DIRECTED WALK
 - DARING WALK

DETERMINED TO SEE

- **Ps 27:13–14 (NLT)** -- ¹³ Yet I am confident I will see the LORD's goodness while I am here in the land of the living. ¹⁴ Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.
- Have a burning desire to see the glory of God.
- Reorient the heart in order to see the kingdom (Jhn 3:3)
- What I see shapes my reality.
 - **Col 3:1–4 (NLT)** -- ¹ Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God's right hand.
- All things are possible to them that believe! (Mt 19:26, Mk 9:23, & Mk 10:27)
 - **Mk 9:23 (NLT)** -- ²³ "What do you mean, 'If I can'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if a person believes."
 - Physics calls faith the "Observer Effect".

DETERMINED TO DO

- Determined to do greater works:
 - **Jn 14:12-14 (NLT)** -- ¹² "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. ¹³ You can ask for anything in my name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. ¹⁴ Yes, ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!"
 - Make bold requests.
- Determined to do the Word, not just a hear it.
 - **Lk 11:28 (NLT)** -- ²⁸ Jesus replied, "But even more blessed are all who hear the word of God and put it into practice."
- Determined to operate in the gifts of the Spirit.
 - I earnestly desire (i.e. strive for and exert myself for) more of God (1 Cor 14:1).
- Determined to seek first the kingdom of God.

DETERMINED TO BE:

- A powerful person in Christ.
 - We walk in kingdom authority when we display His power:
 - **Lk 11:20–22 (NLT)** -- ²⁰ But if I am casting out demons by the power of God, then the Kingdom of God has arrived among you. ²¹ For when a strong man is fully armed and guards his palace, his possessions are safe— ²² until someone even stronger attacks and overpowers him, strips him of his weapons, and carries off his belongings.
- A Christ representative on the earth.
 - **1 Co 3:16 (NLT)** -- ¹⁶ Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you?
 - **1 Co 6:19–20 (NLT)** -- ¹⁹ Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, ²⁰ for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.
