



## New Vision Fellowship Protocols for Attending “In-Person” Service

Please be aware of the following requirements/recommendations as given by NVF’s Healthcare Professionals’ Team.

### Preparing for Worship

- Take your temperature at home prior to coming to Worship. If it is greater than 99.5 degrees (F), please worship with us from your home online.
- Stay at home if you have a temperature, flu-like symptoms, or don’t feel well and please get appropriate medical attention if needed.
- We **STRONGLY** encourage those in more vulnerable groups, who may not be ready for in-person worship, to please join us online until you are comfortable again being in a public gathering.
- Please come with a mask/face covering. This is a part of our continuing effort to keep everyone safe.

### The Worship Service

- In-person worship services and virtual worship services are held at 10:30 AM on Sundays.
- ***Our services will be entirely "contact-free."*** Sermon notes, weekly announcements and giving options will be available on our website (nvfms.org).
- ***We have many ways to give. We encourage you to give using our contactless options but in service giving for cash and checks is available.***

- We ask you to exercise social/physical distancing, except for individual families. Please limit close contact and be mindful of other’s comfort levels.
- Ministry Technicians will direct you to your seat. Families residing in the same household will be seated together.

### The Sanctuary

- The Sanctuary is thoroughly cleaned and sanitized before and after each service. All chemicals used in our sanitizing and cleaning have been approved by the EPA & are CDC recommended and are proven to be effective against COVID-19.
- All air handling systems have been cleaned.
- Air purifiers are in the sanctuary, classrooms, and distributed throughout the building.
- Hand-sanitizing stations are located upon entry, exit and throughout the building.



## **Nursery, Children's, Youth Ministry**

- Children's and Youth ministry (1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade) will meet on designated Sundays in their respective classrooms.
- The classrooms have been equipped with air purifiers, hand sanitizer, and wipes.
- The nursery is currently open on designated Sundays to children ages 2-5. The same in-service protocols are implemented within the nursery.

## **Personal Workers/Altar Call Protocol**

- The Personal Workers room will have limited use with physical distancing. An air purifier, wipes and sanitizer are also located in the room.
- Altar invitations will likely be congregational.
- Contact information will be appropriately gathered from those individuals desiring further ministry. A personal ministry worker will use the contact information to follow up.

## **Other Classes**

- Most classes (i.e. Sunday School, LCGs (small groups)) are being held via Zoom or other online platforms.
- Classes are open for anyone desiring to participate.
