SCRIPTURE

- A troubled soul is a silent killer.
- We must Choose Peace, Receive Peace and Make Peace

CHOOSE PEACE

- <u>Jn 14:27 (NLT) --</u> ²⁷ "I am leaving you with a gift— <u>peace of mind and heart</u>. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.
- Peace is wholeness, completeness, the absence of turmoil, tension or strife.
- Peace is a choice.
 - We must choose between God's peace or the world's peace.
 - <u>1 Co 14:33a (NLT) --</u> ³³ For God is not a God of disorder but of peace...
 - Ps 34:14 (NLT) -- 14 Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it.



RECEIVE PEACE

- Mt 11:28–30 (NLT) -- ²⁸ Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. ³⁰ For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light."
- We must yoke to Jesus.
 - Jesus' yoke is His teachings, it is to follow Him and to be like Him.
 - It is focusing on His WAYS as much as His WORDS.
 - Rest for our soul is something we RECEIVE.

MAKE PEACE

- Peace is made with trust.
 - <u>Is 26:3–4 (NLT) --</u> ³ You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you! ⁴ Trust in the Lord always, for the Lord God is the eternal Rock.
 - <u>Pr 3:5–6 (NLT) --</u> ⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. ⁶ Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.
- True peace cannot be found in a fantasy.
 - <u>2 Pe 3:14 (NLT)</u> -- ¹⁴ And so, dear friends, while you are waiting for these things to happen, make every effort to be found living peaceful lives that are pure and blameless in his sight.
 - Mt 5:9 (NLT) -- 9 God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God.
- Outcomes should not determine peace.

WALK IN GOD'S PEACE

- Choose peace: God's way is true peace
 - <u>Jn 14:27 (NLT) -- ²⁷ "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart</u>. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid.
- Receive Peace: We receive peace by taking His yoke.
